(During the phone menu, choose "Health Care Services", then "All other Health Services", then "Communicable Diseases", then "Venereal diseases")

- Free services and treatments.
- Diagnosis and treatment for anyone requesting medical care for sexually transmitted diseases, including HIV.
- No residency or insurance requirements, except for HIV treatment (see below).
- Free HIV prevention programs (PrEP) to uninsured patients who qualify.
- Free HIV treatment for uninsured patients who qualify.
- Free Hepatitis A & B vaccines to those who are at risk for hepatitis and are not immune.
- Appointments are preferred, but walk-ins are accepted IF the clinic schedule is not full. **To make an appointment, call (714) 834-8787**, listen to their recording, and then leave them a message with what type of testing or services you want with your call-back phone number, and they will call you back in one to two business days to make an appointment for you.
- You may get a same-day appointment if you go to the clinic and get in line at 8:00 AM or at 1:00 PM. (Availability of appointments depends on whether or not they have reached capacity).
- Clinic Hours are:

Monday	8:00 AM - 4:00 PM
Tuesday	10:00 AM - 4:00 PM
Wednesday	8:00 AM - 4:00 PM
Thursday	8:00 AM - 4:00 PM
Friday	8:00 AM - 4:00 PM

- Hours of operation are subject to early closure if they reach patient capacity.
- When visiting the 17th Street Testing & Treatment Clinic, patients are encouraged to use the back parking lot (located off of College Avenue) and enter the building through the rear entrance. There is an information desk inside near the rear entrance.
