1. Credit for Prior Learning – accepting other community colleges’ awarded credit\* – Nicole Diamond (05-07-24) Michelle expressed she is still feel uneasy. Nicole proposes to show how other colleges are doing this and in regards to articulation.
2. Process of adding courses to local GE pattern\* – Nicole Diamond (10-03-23; 10-17-23; 11-07-23; 12-05-23). Currently, faculty are asked to include requests in the justification. We are aiming to have a designated area when we move to CIM – faculty can select area(s) to submit for and an articulation area indicating the status of approve and/or phase out. The goal is to have the form user friendly by listing options in a drop down feature. This is the goal for all articulation elements as well. The goal is to also have CIM display courses that are entered in Banner as equivalent districtwide (not an edit field for faculty) and faculty can verify.

Amy shares the goal of having the SLOs map with iSLOs with Nuventive. Many CCI representatives would like to participate in the testing phase.
