HIST G101 – Critical Thinking and Writing through 3 units Fall 2021 Historical Sources and Literature

New course. Submit for C-ID, local GE, CSU GE, and IGETC. Includes new DE addendum. 1st reading 11/17/20. This course will teach students how to critically think, read, and write as a historian. This will teach students how to analyze and interpret primary sources (wide range of documents that come from the past; photographs, trade records, novels, historical literature, etc.). Students will also review secondary sources such as methodologies, thesis statements, and evidence used. This will prepare major students to succeed as juniors and allow them explore the basic skills of critical reading, writing, and analysis that lines up with their interest/major.

English Department concerns include: History faculty potentially being composition instructors and other comments listed in CurricUNET. Students already do not have the support of ENGL G098 and G099 and enter into G100. Students may barely pass ENGL G100 and could get more composition instruction and structure from ENGL G110.

Counseling advises students to take courses appropriate to their transfer and long term career goals.
