## STEP 1

Create an

account

## STEP 2

Submit an ONLINE

If you are a **new** student or if you *haven't taken a GWC course* in **3+ semesters** submit an online application at **https://bit.ly/gwcapply** 

**RETURNING STUDENTS**: If you took a class at GWC any time during the last **2** semesters (*excluding summer*), you may skip this step.

for processing release forms.



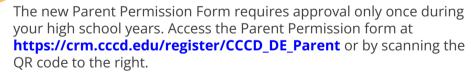
**NEW STUDENTS**: Wait 24 hours to receive a welcome email with your **GWC ID**, **MyGWC Username** and login instructions.

Use your **MyGWC USERNAME** and **PASSWORD** to access the online concurrent enrollment form at **https://bit.ly/gwcform-ce** 

- A new form must be submitted *every semester*
- The form cannot be edited after submission

  If changes need to be made, you will need to submit a new form
- submission does not guarantee class space -

Once you complete steps 1-3, you will be granted permission to register in the approved courses on your registration date.

### STEP 4

Register for GWC classes online in MyGWC

It is the **student's responsibility** to register in Concurrent Enrollment course(s) in MyGWC.

Approved Concurrent Enrollment classes are 100% FREE for HBUHSD students and will be added to both high school and college transcripts.

#### **ORDER TEXTBOOKS**

#### **BUYING YOUR TEXTBOOKS ONLINE:**

- Select the **Financial Aid or FSA option** and enter your **GWC ID number** when checking out to charge the school district.
