HOW TO ENROLL IN GWC CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT COURSES

APPROXIMATE PROCESSING
TIMELINE: 3 WEEKS

STEP 1

Create an
OpenCCC account

CREATE AN ACCOUNT for California Community Colleges.

STEP 2

Submit an **ONLINE APPLICATION**

ADMISSIONS APPLICATION: For **new** students or students who *haven't taken a GWC course* in 3+ semesters. Find the application here:

RETURNING STUDENTS: If you took a class at GWC during the last 2 semesters (*excluding summer*), you may skip this step.



2 - 3 BUSINESS DAYS

STEP 3

Complete GWC's
CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT RELEASE FORM

NEW STUDENTS: Wait 24 hours to receive a welcome email with your GWC ID, MyGWC Username and login instructions.

Use your MyGWC USERNAME and PASSWORD to access the **online concurrent enrollment form**:

- A new form must be submitted *every semester*
- Form cannot be edited after submission

*If changes need to be made, you will need to submit a new form - **submission does not guarantee class space** -*



1 - 2 WEEKS



NEW PARENT PERMISSION FORM

The new Parent Permission Form requires approval only once during your high school years. This simplifies the process, keeping your parent's consent valid for all relevant courses until the age of 18. https://crm.cccd.edu/register/CCCD_DE_Parent



INTERSESSION/SPRING 2025 PRIORITY DEADLINE

Nov 8, 2024

Once you complete steps 1-3, you will be granted permission to register in the approved courses on your registration date.

STEP 4

Register for GWC classes online in **MyGWC**

It is the **student's responsibility** to register in Concurrent Enrollment course(s) using the registration portal in MyGWC: www.mygwc.com
