#### **Curriculum Priorities**

- Curriculum Clean Up for Accreditation
  - Courses and programs require updating every 5 years (3 years for CTE)
  - Currently 88 courses have a last outline revision date from 2018 and earlier
  - Work to revise offered courses and retire those not being offered
- Transition to the New Curriculum Management System
  - Fall 2025 transition to CourseLeaf
  - No curriculum system during Summer 2025

## Legislation Updates

- Common Course Numbering (AB 1111)
  - Student facing common course numbering for general education and transfer courses
  - Full implementation by Fall 2027 (extended)
  - 6 courses (Fall 2024), 20 courses (Spring 2025), and 50 courses (Fall 2025)
  - First 6 courses: ENGL G100, ENGL G110, CMST G110, MATH G160, PSCI G180, PSYC G100
- Cal-GETC (AB 928)
  - Consolidates CSUGE and IGETC into one single general education pattern
  - Local general education remains

Course outcomes/objectives	2 Parts: 1 <sup>st</sup> is identical, 2 <sup>nd</sup> is optional local addition
Methods of Evaluation	2 Parts: 1 <sup>st</sup> is identical, 2 <sup>nd</sup> is an optional local addition
Representative Texts	2 Parts: 1 <sup>st</sup> is identical, 2 <sup>nd</sup> is an optional local addition



#### Curriculum Processes

- CCI meets the 1st and 3rd Tuesday of the month from 3:00-5:00 p.m.
- Tech Review meets the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Tuesday of the month from 3:00-5:00 p.m.
- Submission deadline is 3:00 p.m. Thursday prior to be considered for the CCI agenda
- CCI is not the last level of approval:
  - Curriculum can be delayed or not approved by the Board of Trustees, State Chancellor's Office, or articulation (C-ID, UCTCA, Cal-GETC)
  - Returned items may result in delayed effective dates to the following year
  - Plan ahead! Curriculum needs to run for 1 year before being brought back for revisions (exceptions may include regulatory changes, ie. AB 1111)

#### Curriculum Approvals: Why Does it Take so Long?



- Tech Review and two readings at CCI is just the first step
- Many levels of approvals
- Board of Trustees approvals 1-2x per month
- CCCCO is 60 days from submission and any items returned for edits go to the end of the line
- UCTCA is 1x per year (and is required before Cal-GETC submission
- Cal-GETC is 1x per year

## Most Frequent Corrections from the State

- Course title of the COR is not identical to
  - Narrative
  - Advisory minutes
  - Regional Consortia
  - TMC
  - In curriculum inventory
- Mismatch MIS elements on COR and degrees and certificates
- Calculation of units

#### Most Frequent Corrections from the State

- Articulation proof / documents of approval
  - Articulation agreement by major (AAM)
  - CSU Baccalaureate level course list by department (BCT) for transfer
  - CSU GE certification course list by area (GECC)
  - Course identification numbering system (C-ID)
