



Estimated Expenses for International Students

Estimated registration costs and living expenses for international students at Golden West College are listed below. International student tuition for the 2024-2025 academic year is **\$485 USD per unit**. The tuition and fee estimates below are calculated based on enrollment in 12 units in the Fall and Spring semesters. Tuition and fee amounts are subject to change without notice.

Tuition and college fees are due immediately upon registration.

Proof of sufficient funds for tuition, fees, and living expenses for one year are required for issuance of the Form I-20. Students who will bring dependent spouses or children to the U.S. as F-2 visa holders need to show proof of additional \$3000 per dependent.
