**CSU DOMINGUEZ HILLS:** RN-BSN Program only. Must have Associate Degree in Nursing + valid RN license for BSN degree completion program.

**CSU FULLERTON:** Pre-licensure pathway must complete integrated chemistry (CHEM G110) along with other remaining CSU-GE requirements.

**RN-BSN Program Admission Requirements.** Students must meet requirements for admission to the university as a transfer student; have an associate degree in nursing or its equivalent and current licensure as a Registered Nurse in California. Completion of college level prerequisite courses with a minimum "C" grade or better in each course listed.

2.1 Pre-licensure pathway must complete integrated chemistry (CHEM G110). RN-BSN can complete either CHEM G110, CHEM G130, or CHEM G180

2.2: Accelerated BSN and Entry-Level MSN programs available for those who have already earned a BA/BS Degree in another discipline. See <http://nursing.fullerton.edu/programs/index.php> for more information.

**CSU LONG BEACH:** All nursing programs at this campus are impacted. Please see counselor for admission and selection criteria for this major. Two options available: Nursing – Basic Pre-licensure, and Nursing – Registered Nurse (RN-BSN with an Associate Degree in Nursing and a valid California RN License). Admission to the nursing major in the School of Nursing requires a separate application. All students subject to criminal background check, health insurance, immunizations, medical clearance, and malpractice insurance are required for clinical coursework. **CSU LOS ANGELES:** All nursing programs at this campus are impacted. Please see counselor for admission and selection criteria for this major. Four options available: Nursing – Pre-licensure (Basic); RN Transfer (RN-BSN); The Associate Degree in Nursing to BSN CC Collaborative Option (ADN to BSN); and the BSN Accelerated Option (ABSN). Admission to the nursing major in the School of Nursing requires a separate application. Pre-licensure requires a minimum 3.25 GPA and minimum TEAS score of 40th percentile for consideration. Volunteer or work experience recommended. **UC IRVINE:** Admission to the major is limited and selective. Junior-level applicants with the highest grades overall and who satisfactorily complete course prerequisites will be given preference for admission to the Nursing Science major. *Applicants must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher to be considered, minimum "B" grades in the following:* All courses listed above, plus genetics equivalent to UCI's Biological Sciences 97; biochemistry equivalent to UCI's Biological Sciences 98; human physiology with lab equivalent to UCI's BIOSCI E109 + E112L; human anatomy with lab equivalent to UCI's NURSCI 100 + 100L; one quarter/semester of public health equivalent to UCI's PUBHLTH 1. Please see a counselor for exact course equivalents.

6.1: Approved for subject credit and lower division credit for the Nursing Science major only.

6.2: Select one course from: PSYC G100, G260, or HLED G220.

6.3 : Select one: SOC G100, G110, G185, ANTH G100, G190, or PSYC G260.

6.4 : Select one statistics course from: MATH G160, PSYC G140, or BIOL G260

6.5 : Coursework equivalent to BIOSCI 97, 98 available at OCC: BIOL A281, BIOL A283. Additional course in Public Health (PUBHLTH 1) required at UCI. See counselor for options on completing this course prior to transfer.

**UCLA:** This is a three-year program and highly impacted. Minimum 3.5 GPA in all UC-Transferable coursework required. Applicants to the nursing program must complete a supplementary application with the School of Nursing which includes two letters of recommendation from appropriate sources, a statement of purpose, completion of IGETC. The Nursing/Prelicensure program is not open to second baccalaureate applicants. Students with a non-nursing baccalaureate degree should apply for the Masters Entry Clinical Nurse (MSN/MECN) program. **Azuza Pacific University:** Undergraduate programs available in Basic/preOlicensure, RN-BSN, LVN-BSN, and accelerated BSN program available at the High Desert Regional campus only.

8.2: campus requires additional coursework in Fine Arts, Literature, History, and Biblical/Theology requirements for graduation.

**Mt. Saint Mary's College:** Basic / Pre-Licensure and RN-BSN Options available. 3.0 overall and 2.7 science GPA required.
