A1: List A choice: Select two of the following: SOC G110, SOC G140 or ANTH G200, SOC G111, G115, G133, G134, PSYC G260.

B1: List B choice: One additional course from List A, or ANTH G100, ECON G110, GEOG G100, GLST G100, G101, GEOG G185, PHIL G100, PSCI G100, PSYC G100

CSU DOMINGUEZ HILLS: BA Sociology.

CSU FULLERTON: BA Sociology. Concentrations available in General Sociology; Health and Social Welfare; Social Inequalities; and Sociology of Deviance and Crime.

CSU LONG BEACH: BA Sociology. All majors at this campus are impacted. Please see counselor for admission and selection criteria for this major. Minimum 2.25 GPA required and completion of major preparation coursework above for admission. Degree requirements for Sociology major. Additional major of BSW: Bachelor of Social Work available (Highly Impacted Major). Minimum 2.5 GPA required for consideration. SOC G100 & SOC G185 are not required for BSW but highly recommended. Add BIOL G221, PSY G100. Departmental application Required. Fall only. Please see <http://www.csulb.edu/colleges/chhs/departments/social-work/> for additional criteria and application packet.

CSU LOS ANGELES: BA Sociology. Options are available in General Sociology; Inequalities and Diversity; Law and Society; and Social Gerontology.

UC BERKELEY: BA Degrees in Sociology and Social Welfare available. Social Welfare is an impacted major. Transfer students must complete all lower division prerequisites for the major prior to fall enrollment at Berkeley. Transfer students have the opportunity to declare their major during the summer transfer orientations at Berkeley.

- 4.1: A course in Logic (PHIL G115) is required for Sociology major.
- 4.2: Additional coursework recommended as preparation for Social Welfare Major: PSYC 100, ANTH G100, ECON G170 + G175, PSCI G180

UC IRVINE: BA Sociology. Options are available in Social Ecology and Social Policy & Public Service. There is no prerequisite course work required for admission to the Sociology major. The School of Social Sciences recommends that students wishing to transfer to UCI complete IGETC prior to transfer and refer to the list of courses that will fulfill UCI lower-division major requirements.

- 5.1: Major requires both MATH G160 and MATH G180 or PSYC G140 and MATH G180.
- 5.2: One additional Social Science course. Select one from: ANTH G150, ECON G110, HIST G110, PSCI G110, G130, G180, G185, PSY G116, G118, G250, G255, SOC G110, G133, G134, G185.

UCLA: BA Sociology. Major is highly selective. All courses must be taken for a letter grade. The Sociology department requires that you complete all major preparation courses prior to transfer. Transfer students must be admitted to Pre-Sociology majors in order to change their major to Sociology. *After transferring to UCLA, students may not change their major to Sociology if they were originally admitted to another major outside of the Department of Sociology.*

UC RIVERSIDE: BA or BS Degree options available. Minimum 2.40 GPA required for consideration. Options in Administrative Studies, and Law and Society available. Although completion of the course work listed is not mandatory prior to admission, students are advised to complete as much lower division course preparation as possible prior to transfer.

- 7.1: In addition, complete an additional two lower-division UC transferable Sociology courses.
- 7.2: Administrative Studies Option: add BUS G100, ACCT G101, CS G130, and MATH G160 (or AP Statistics Exam with a score of 4 or better).
- 7.3: Law and Society Option: add PHIL G115

UC SAN DIEGO: BA Degrees in General Sociology or one of seven concentrations: International Studies; American Studies; Culture and Communication; Social Inequalities; Law and Society; Economy and Society; and Science and Medicine available. Transfer students are strongly advised to complete as many preparatory courses as soon as possible for their major before enrolling at UCSD.

- 8.1: Select one additional UC Transferable Sociology course
